**SUBJECT:** Series Race Procedures

#### 1. If Entries In A Class Are LESS Than 34

All karts will participate in qualifying.

All karts will participate in the Pre-Final.

The finishing positions in the Pre-Final will determine the starting grid for the Final.

#### 2. If Entries In A Class Are GREATER Than 34

A maximum of 34 karts will be allowed to start in the Final.

All karts will participate in qualifying.

The top 20 karts from qualifying will be guaranteed a starting position in the Final in the order of their qualifying times. These 20 karts will not participate in a Pre-Final.

A Second Chance race will be held in the place of a Pre-Final for karts in qualifying positions 21 and higher. A maximum of 34 karts will be allowed to start in the Second Chance race.

The top 14 finishers in the Second Chance race will start the Final in positions 21 to 34.

There are no consolation races for karts and drivers who do not qualify to participate in the Final.

This procedure may be modified at the event by the Series Steward. The maximum number of entries accepted at an event in any class is 54.

### 3. Length Of Races – Number Of Laps

#### 4. Use Of The Blue With Red "X" Overlap Flag

This flag will be used in all Finals. It will not be used in Pre-Finals or Second Chance races.

It is shown to a driver about to be lapped. The driver must stop racing, maintain racing speed and return directly to the pits. Failure to obey this flag will result in a BLACK flag with kart number being shown, the driver will be excluded and additional penalties may be issued.

When a driver returns to the pits after being shown the Blue With Red "X" flag they will be scored in the position they were in the last time they crossed over the timing and scoring line.
